1. WHERE THERE'S FIRE The French Barrel Oak Contempo Fire table from American Fyre looks and feels like wood but is built to withstand the elements. Burn media includes logs, stones, glass, propane or natural gas, \$2,240. americanfyredesigns.com

2. SHADY PROPOSITION An umbrella is a must for a sunny deck or patio, and Treasure Garden innovates with its 10-foot octagonal tilting Lotus design. When closed, it retracts upward like a lotus flower, \$635. treasuregarden.com

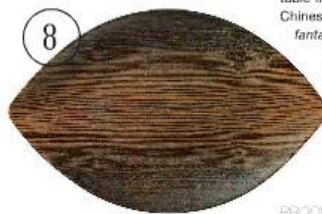
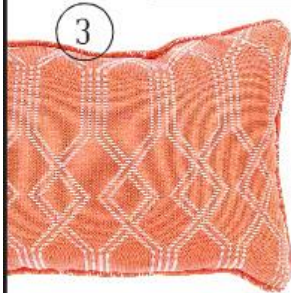
